NEW STUDENT PRE-ARRIVAL CHECKLIST

☐ Visa Preparations Before Arrival in USA

In order to enter the USA, you must have all your documents (Passport, Visa, I-20, School Registration Letter) and be ready to present them to an immigration official when asked.

Visa Denials: Do not wait until your I-20 date has expired!

- If you did not pass your Embassy interview and want to reschedule: It is the student's responsibility to communicate with Capstone if the date on the I-20 needs to be deferred. The new I-20 date must be at least one month from the previous one.
- If you are unable to reschedule your Embassy interview: It is the student's responsibility to communicate with Capstone if you want to cancel student enrollment.

Upon arrival in USA: Contact Capstone at <u>admissions@capstone.org</u> or (503) 228-6346! Students may enter the USA no more than 30 days prior to their I-20 start date but please take care of school business BEFORE your scheduled Orientation.

□ Scheduling Arrival in USA

Students must arrive in Portland, Oregon at least THREE WEEKS before their I-20 start date. Why?

- Because the date on your I-20 is the day you will begin classes at Capstone.
- Because you must attend Orientation and Placement Test which is scheduled two weeks BEFORE your Start Date.
- Because understanding transportation in Portland and the location of the school will help make your first day of classes successful.

Preparing for Orientation and Placement Test

Your Orientation & Placement Test is scheduled 2 weeks BEFORE your start date @ 12:30 pm

- You are required to pay for your first installment of \$1100 on your Orientation day. There are no refunds.
- Please bring your I-94, Passport, & I-20 with you. You will be asked to confirm your U.S. address, email and phone #.
- There is a \$100 charge if you don't show up. Missing your Orientation day may result in cancellation of your I-20.
- Check your email for information and important dates sent by the school, respond if you have questions.

☐ First Day of School, check in at the front desk from 9:00 - 9:45 am

- Before your first day at Capstone, you will receive an email confirming your start date and class schedule.
- Please arrive early on your first day of school to check in at the front desk. Capstone opens at 9:00 am.
- You have already made your first tuition payment and now you will be required to purchase your textbooks. You must purchase your textbooks at the front desk and before you enter the classroom. No Books = No Class.
- Please come to class prepared, on time and ready to learn.

Capstone Vacation Policy

After completing 3 terms of study at Capstone, students can apply for 1 term of vacation in the USA
